

# Foundation Horse Registry Performance Points Program

The Foundation Horse Registry is proud to sponsor our Performance Points Program for members and their horses. Foundation horses were bred to be a valuable asset to rural American life. The Foundation horse could be used for work all week, raced Saturday night and then driven to church on Sunday. The Foundation Horse Registry would like to recognize the accomplishments of the horses registered with us by sponsoring this performance program for members. Horses enrolled in the program will earn points that will be recorded on their permanent record. In keeping with tradition, the program will emphasize Western working/ performance classes. Any event OPEN to all breeds or sponsored by FHR can qualify and placing can transfer into points with our program..

## **Enrollment**

Download an application from the website or email, write, phone and request one be sent to you.

Submit application and annual enrollment fee of \$25.00 per horse. The program runs from Jan 1 through Dec 31 and must be renewed each year.

You will receive several report forms and a Foundation Performance Points Program card.

## **Requirements**

- The horse must be registered with FHR to be enrolled in the program.
- The owner and rider (if other than owner) must maintain a current FHR membership(s) during competition.
- The event must be designated as OPEN to all breeds or sponsored by FHR..
- 4H shows using the Danish System are NOT eligible
- Enter any Open horse show/ competition. When you place in the event, present your Foundation Performance Points Program card and report form to the show secretary or manager.
- Ask the official to check your enrollment card, FHR membership card and the horse's registration papers to verify your participation on a registered Foundation Quarter Horse. Then request the official to fill out and sign the report form.
- Return the report, along with a show schedule or bill, to FHR within 30 days of the event. Please use 1 form per show/ competition, but multiple forms may be returned together.
- All reports from Dec. competitions must be received by Jan. 10 due to end of year rush.

## **Recognitions**

At year end, each participant will receive a certificate showing yearly and cumulative points awarded.

A plaque will be awarded to the top points earner in each category.

A Plaque plus other prizes will be awarded to your horse when it reaches:

- 50 points in any 1 category.
- 100 points in any 2 or more categories.
- 100 points in any 2 or more divisions
- Division Points Champion
- 2-D horses earning 200 points in 2 or more divisions
- 3-D-The top 3 horses earning the most points in at least 3 different divisions

Horses that earn plaques will be recognized on the FHR web site.

The Foundation Perform Points are subject to verification. Anyone found to be submitting false reports will lose all points and be restricted from participating in the program.

Prizes may be changed at any time due to availability

## How points are awarded:

### **Point system for 4H events**

Purple ribbon = 3 points

Blue ribbon= 2 points

Red ribbon= 1 point

White ribbon = 0 points

### **Point system for all other events**

1<sup>st</sup> place= 5 points

2<sup>nd</sup> place= 4 points

3<sup>rd</sup> place = 3 points

4<sup>th</sup> place= 2 points

5<sup>th</sup> place =1 point

### **Point system for Champions**

Grand Champion= 2 points

Reserve Grand champion=1 point
